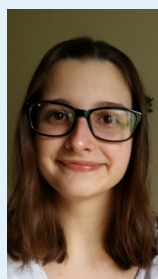
Terrance is a Lincoln West High School senior with a GPA of 3.4. He was on the

Second Harvest Senior Food Box Distribution

Once a month, Second Harvest will be delivering food boxes to Kennedy Plaza, Riverview Plaza, and Harr Plaza. These boxes contain 40-50 pounds of various foods including fresh fruits and vegetables! To be eligible, individuals must be age 60 or older and living on no more than 130% of the Federal Poverty Level (\$15782 for one person). Upcoming delivery dates are:
