## From the Managers

- LMHA's offices are open however LMHA offices are temporarily closed to the public. ## COVID-19 Economic Impact Payment Updates

SSI recipients that do not file taxes will start receiving their automatic Economic Impact Payments directly from the treasury department in early May. People receiving SSI benefits who did not file 2018 or 2019 taxes and have qualifying children under age 17 should not wait for their automatic \$1,200 individual payment. They should immediately go to the IRS's webpage at [www.irs.gov/coronavirus/non-filers-enter-payment-info-here](http://www.irs.gov/coronavirus/non-filers-enter-payment-info-here) and visit *Non-Filers: Enter Your Information* section to provide their information. **SSI recipients who have dependent children and did not file 2018 or 2019 taxes need to act by Tuesday, May 5, 2020 in order to receive additional payments for their eligible children quickly.**
